WHEREAS, the Pennsauken Board of Education wishes to deposit anticipated current year surplus into a Capital Reserve account, and

WHEREAS, Pennsauken Board of Education has determined that up to \$1,000,000.00 is available for such purpose of transfer,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education that it hereby authorizes the district's School Business Administrator to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.

WHEREAS, Pennsauken Board of Education has determined that up to \$243,000 is available for such purpose of transfer,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education that it hereby authorizes the district's School Business Administrator to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.
