Degree Paths: General Studies Transfer Degree, Welding, Process Technology, Instrumentation, Nursing, Criminal Justice, Culinary, Computer Technology, Graphic Art, Drafting and other programs in the SOWELA Catalog.

Students who participate can expect to earn 24-30 college credit hours. These credit hours will apply to their Technical, Associates or Bachelor's degree and fulfill any remaining high school graduation requirements. Almost all general education classes will transfer to other colleges.

Value of this opportunity is \$1,600.00 per semester.

Admission Requirements:

ACT of 18 in English or Accuplacer Writing 250+ and 20 in Math or Accuplacer QRAS 250+ and AAF 220+.
GPA of 2.5

Transitional Option Requirements:

ACT of 17 in English and 17-19 in Math.
