Athletics/Sports

Sports can be used to fulfill the LBHS requirement of 20 credits of PE

- Tryouts are required for all sports teams.
- If a student makes a team, their counselor will add the sport to their schedule once coaches submit rosters in the fall/winter/spring.
- Fall and Winter sports are listed on fall schedules and transcripts, spring sports are listed on spring schedules and transcripts.
- All 9th and 10th grade students must enroll in PE or an after-school sport.
- If a student drops or is cut from the after-school sport prior to earning 20 credits, the student
 must take PE to fulfill the graduation requirement.
- Students who quit or are removed from a sport are subject to a withdraw/fail "W/F." See Student Handbook.
- To participate in try-outs and sports during the school year, a Breakers Athletics Online Packet MUST be completed online at <u>www.AthleticClearance.com</u>. No exceptions.


