### 1. PRELIMINARY

Call to Order: The Measure "G" Citizen's Oversight Committee meeting was called to order by John-Paul Wells at 5:00 p.m. Committee members in attendance at the start of the meeting were: Lucy Hendry, Chris Stergios, Chris Strahm, Katie Turner, Joan Thornburg, and Eric Lyerly.

#### 2. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

The motion to adopt the agenda was made by Lucy Hendry and seconded by Katie Turner. The motion passed unanimously.

#### 3. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF COMMITTEE CHAIR & VICE-CHAIR

Joan Thornburg moved to nominate and elect Chris Stergios as Chair of the Oversight Committee and Lucy Hendry as Vice-Chair. The motion passed unanimously.

#### 4. INFORMATION/DISCUSSION

Wells provided a PowerPoint Presentation to the Committee that covered the following topics:

- a) <u>Committee Bylaws</u> Wells provided the Committee with a copy of the board-approved bylaws and covered sections such as the purpose/duties of the committee, membership provisions, ethics standards, and meeting requirements.
- b) <u>Measure "G" Project List</u> Wells detailed the 4 project priorities that were determined prior to the November election, and explained that the projects were presented at a public forum prior to election day. The projects, in order of priority are: HMS Gym/Multipurpose and Field Lights, HHS Cafeteria/Multipurpose, Pine Student Services Building, and Finley Classrooms/Offices.
- c) <u>Bond Issuance Process</u> Wells provided an overview of the Bond, highlighting the Authorization of \$10 million, the tax rate stated in the election of \$40 per \$100,000 of assessed property value, and the bond issuance process. Wells advised that the District sold the first issuance of \$4 million on 5/21/2019, hitting the market at a favorable time, yielding an All-Inclusive Total Interest Cost (TIC) of 3.82%.
- d) <u>Report of Expenditures</u> Wells advised that to date, \$0 had been spent from Measure "G" funds, as no funds had yet been deposited to the District. However, Wells explained that the HMS Gym Project has incurred planning costs that may be reimbursed by Bond funds. Wells handed out a financial report from the District's accounting system detailing the \$22,675 in costs that have been paid thus far.
- e) <u>Other Information</u> Wells also showed the Committee sample pictures and schematics of the planned HMS Gym/Multipurpose as well as a slide from the pre-election community forum which showed the tax rates per \$100,000 for other Imperial County districts.
















### Building Design – Site View




### Building Design – Top View

# ow do Holtville bond tax rates ompare to other communities?

- At close of 2017-18, Holtville's bond rate for the 2002 bond is \$52.40/\$100,000/yr
- This is the lowest unified district rate
  - San Pasqual = \$176.09
  - Calipatria = \$146.80
  - Calexico = \$98.60
  - Imperial = \$95.00
- Other community rates with split elementary/high school districts:
  - Brawley Elementary = \$79.80
  - ▶ Westmorland = \$33.30
  - Brawley Union High School = \$28.50 (high school) + \$30.00? (Nov 18 Election)
  - ▶ El Centro Elementary = \$62.10
  - Meadows Elementary = \$49.30
  - McCabe Elementary = \$26.10
  - Seeley Elementary = \$78.90
  - ▶ Heber Elementary = \$38.00 + \$30.00? (Nov 18 Election)
  - Central Union High School = \$52.00
