

Students can access popular digital magazine subscriptions right from their chromebook using the SORA app located in Classlink. Students' access to the collection is filtered by graduating year, so sixth grade has unlimited access to the juvenile collection. Seventh and eighth graders have access to over 200 magazines, and staff can peruse over 400 subscriptions. Users can borrow as many magazines as they want to read, and with simultaneous use, an entire class or grade can be borrowing and acessing at the same time.




