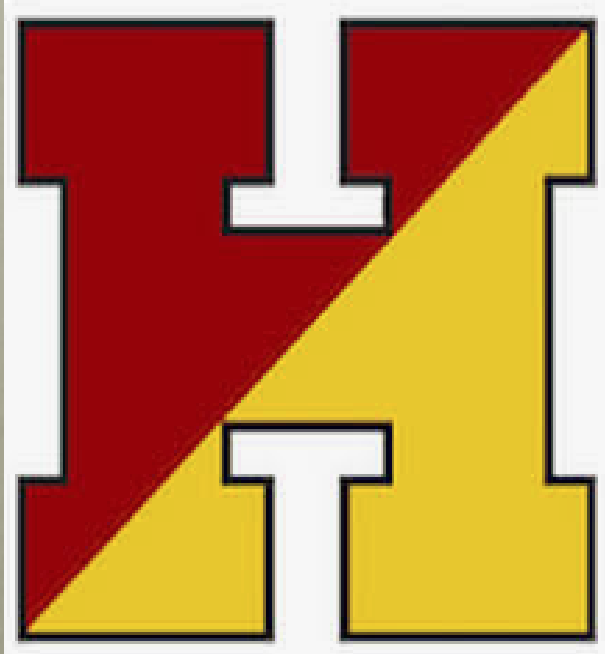
- We allow water to be carried in school

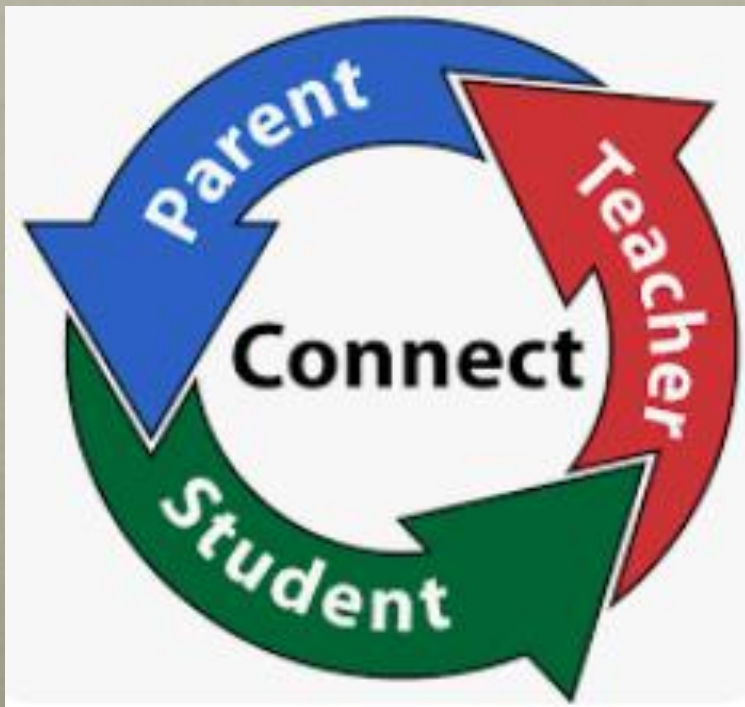
