

During months of detailed planning, Cleburne ISD and the Facility Advisory Committee (FAC) — a group of community members, parents, business leaders, and district stakeholders — conducted a comprehensive review of its infrastructure and facilities, as well as student enrollment projections, to determine the facility improvements for this bond election.

The process involved assessing the condition and capacity of existing buildings, identifying areas of improvement, and incorporating community input to shape the final proposal presented and approved by the Board of Trustees.

The proposed 2025 May Bond focuses on updating and expanding facilities to address growth and programming goals.

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

The bond is divided into two propositions that will fund projects across the district:

Prop A (\$137,600,000):

- **Replacement of Cooke Elementary and Gerard Elementary:** two new 92,000 sq. ft. campuses for 750 students each
- **Expansion of Marti Elementary:** 10 new classrooms, new storm shelter with restrooms, and integration with the existing school building
- **Renovation and expansion of the A.D. Wheat Agriculture Center:** Ag Barn Proposition—a 22,000 square-foot building including animal pens, classroom space, restrooms, additional parking and more

Prop B (\$27,400,000):

- **New multi-use stadium at Cleburne High School:** to serve as a 5,500-seat venue for athletics, fine arts, and community events, with a two-story press box and multipurpose meeting spaces, home-side concessions, restrooms, ticketing areas, storage, concrete plaza, walkways, and more.

TAX RATE IMPACT

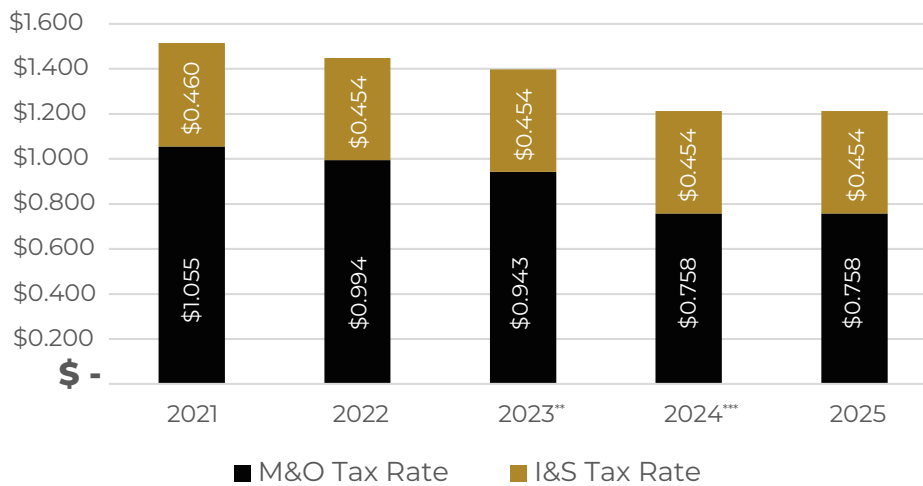
The I&S Tax Rate will be maintained at \$0.4544.

If the Bond is passed, the district does not anticipate any increase in the overall tax rate. Future increases or decreases in districtwide property appraised values, or significant improvements to your property, may affect your tax bill, regardless of whether the Bond passes or fails.

State law requires all school district bond propositions to include the statement "THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE".

At this time, the district does not anticipate an increase to the overall tax rate of \$1.21190.
