STUDENT COUNCIL CODE OF CONDUCT

Officers and members of Student Council are leaders in the school. As such, integrity, honesty, respect, and responsibility are expected behaviors.

Student council operates on a demerit system. A student receiving three demerits will be dismissed from student council. Demerits are received from missing meetings, missing mandatory events, and other infractions. Members will receive notification letter from President and Advisor on status of membership.

Behaviors/incidents resulting in immediate dismissal are noted below.

- 1) NO ISS. First offense is a warning. Second offense will result in immediate removal.
- 2) **NO INSUBORDINATION** towards the advisor, teachers, and other administrators.
- 3) NO LEVEL 3 DISCIPLINE OFFENSE (SMOKING, DRINKING, DRUGS, OR WEAPONS) immediate dismissal
- 4) **NO REPEATED DETENTION ASSIGNMENT**. More than two times in a nine-week period will result in a warning; next detention assignment may result in removal from the council.
- 5) NO OSS OR EMERGENCY REMOVAL. Immediate dismissal from the council.
- 6) NO FIGHTING OR BULLYING.
- 7) **MAINTAIN PASSING GRADES**. Student Council is an extracurricular activity that meets before school during tutoring hours. Receiving a failing grade on a UIL report card or progress report may result in dismissal from the council.
- 8) **FULFILL ALL OBLIGATIONS** set by the officers/advisor, including projects, workshops, and related responsibilities.
- 9) ATTEND ALL MEETINGS unless preauthorized by the advisor or in the event of an emergency.
- 10) ALL STUDENT COUNCIL MEMBERS MUST FOLLOW THE PISD STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT.

I have read and understand that Student Council students are to adhere to the code of conduct listed above and realize that a violation could result in removal from Student Council. All final decisions are based on the student advisor's discretion.
