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## ***BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS***

February 11, 2025

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Board President Adams announced that the Board took action in closed session to issue a notice of non-re-election to seven (7) temporary certificated employees, pursuant to Education Code Section 44954, effective at the end of the 2024-2025 school year, and directed the Superintendent or designee to send out appropriate legal notices. The roll call vote was as follows: Ayes: 5; Nays: 0; Abstentions: 0.

### General Business, Board Reports

- Board Members shared information regarding committee reports and other community related activities.

### Superintendent's Report

- Above & Beyond Recognition
  - The Board and Superintendent Hays recognized Pete Frias for going *Above and Beyond* for the Flory School students, staff and families.
- 2024-2025 MUSD LCAP Survey Results
  - Dr. Wagmeister, Rosalinda Silva and Jennifer Silva reviewed the 2024-2025 LCAP survey results that included: the top three ranked priorities for all parents, students and staff; parent engagement; and the climate survey responses from parents, staff and students.

### Board Items for Action/Discussion

- The Board reviewed the VCOE letter accepting the District's positive certification for the 2024-2025 first period interim report.

### Personnel

- The Board unanimously approved:
  - Classified employment report;
  - MOU with MEA regarding hourly pay rate for middle school teachers to pilot ELOP Plus and provide targeted interventions afterschool to students at the middle school level for 24-25 school year only;
  - Student teaching MOUs with University of Laverne, California Lutheran University and CSUCI;
- A public hearing was held to sunshine the District's initial proposals to reopen negotiations with MEA for the 24-25 school year, including: Article V: Working Hours and Calendars; and Article XIII: Leaves. Following the public hearing, the Board unanimously approved the District's initial proposals for reopeners with the MEA as noted.
- The Board unanimously approved the following new job descriptions: MHS Varsity Head Football Coach and MHS Varsity Head Basketball Coach.

### Instructional Services

- The 2024-2025 VCOE Quarter 2 Williams Report for Ivy Tech School was disclosed for October-December 2024 visitation period, indicating all areas reviewed were found to be in compliance.
- Dr. Jane Wagmeister, Melissa LaBelle and Juan Pablo Herrera reviewed a PowerPoint presentation for the District's 2024-2025 Mid-Year LCAP Annual Update.
- The 2023-2024 School Accountability Report Cards (SARCs) are completed and were posted on the District's website on February 1, 2025 as mandated by law. Additionally, and in accordance with Education Code, the

District notified parents that the SARCs were available for review. This item is for public reporting purposes only, no Board action is required.

- The Board unanimously approved the resolution in recognition of Black History Month, February 2025.

#### Business Services

- The Board unanimously approved the proposal submitted by AMS.NET to install 244 network drops within all classrooms and learning spaces at MHS.
