COUNSELORS CORNER

We are still focusing on value-Honesty.

4 Helpful tips about HONESTY:

- Don't invite a child to lie by asking a question. Instead, make a corrective statement and move on. For example: Instead of asking, "Did you leave the door open? Say, "I know you left the door open, try to remember to shut it next time."
- 2. Be honest yourself. It is very hard to convince your children not to lie if they see you doing it.
- 3. Help children understand that mistakes are learning opportunities, and if they blame others for their mistakes, they give away their opportunities to learn.
- 4. Let your children know they are loved unconditionally. Always separate what they do from who they are.
