The Faculty Scholarship Committee, when awarding scholarships, use Gold "L" points as criteria for selection.

#### STATE LAW PROHIBIT INDIVIDUAL SALES ON CAMPUS

CA Education Code § 51520 prohibits outside organizations from soliciting pupils on school property during school hours, as well as one hour before and one hour after school. Education Code § 51521 requires that all organizations that conduct fundraising to benefit clubs, schools, students or the district at the K-12 level have prior approval from the school district's governing board.

Individual staff or students may not conduct their own fundraising on campus for personal use. State law prohibits any solicitation—sales or other requests for money—of students on campus except by

district-controlled programs, such as the Cafeteria, Student Store, Student Clubs, Parent Booster Clubs, or other board-approved groups. Individual students, teachers and other employees do not fall into these categories. An individual's fundraising would be taxable income to that individual, reportable to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and Franchise Tax Board. Student body groups may participate in the district's special income tax exempt status, but individuals may not.



#### STUDENT PARKING APPLICATION 2024-2025

#### **STUDENT PARKING RULES:**

- 1. Student parking is restricted to student parking areas only. Students may park in the **Lomina Street** lot (adjacent to the football stadium) (See reverse side and sign to show that you acknowledge specific student parking areas). All other on-campus parking areas are reserved for staff.
- A parking permit placard will be issued to each applicant upon completion of this form with copies of required documents (see #6 below) and the payment of \$5. For a vehicle to be legally parked on campus, the placard must be affixed to the <u>rearview mirror</u>. There will be one placard per vehicle license plate number per student. Sharing/duplicating of parking permits will result in immediate disciplinary action as well as permanent revocation of parking permit. YOU WILL RECEIVE ONE WARNING. AFTERWARDS, FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE PARKING RULES WILL RESULT IN A \$40 FINE FOR EACH VIOLATION AND CAR TOWED.
- 3. Parking spaces are available only for Senior Gold and Red members of SHARP, seniors who meet SHARP requirements for both semesters and maintain good attendance.
- 4. There are no refunds if the parking privilege is revoked.
- 5. Parking Permits expire at the end of the school year. You must reapply each school year.
- 6. All applicants must provide photocopies of the following:
  - Valid California Driver's License.

POLICY #:

- Proof of current liability insurance (including policy #, expiration date and telephone number of your insurance company).
- Current vehicle registration with license plate number appearing on the front.
  - 7. If someone is wrongfully parked in the student parking lot, it is the responsibility of the student to notify the Activities Office as soon as the violation occurs. This is the nature of the lot. No refunds. Attendance at Lakewood and a legally displayed parking permit in no way entitles or guarantees the student a parking space at Lakewood. Student parking spaces are on a first come, first served basis. *A valid parking permit entitles the driver to park in their designated student parking space only.* Otherwise, they will be subject to a \$40 fine for each violation. All rules are subject to change.

If a student parks in a staff lot, or any other unauthorized spaces, that student's vehicle will be subject to fines,
