President's Report: Nothing new. Jennifer Fabrizio may be the treasurer next year, will talk with Ann.

Hospitality Report: Halloween treats on the 25th. Will do sign up genius for candy. Thanksgiving event will be a potato bar on November 15th and fixings will be asked by donations. Star Breakfast is on December 4th.

Communication Report: Carol was not in attendance. The Invest form did go out with the different donation levels so will be ordering tees and magnets. Discussed having an opt out option to have all the money donated stay in the school.

Fundraising Report: Current amount for Invest is \$14,205.64 and there has not been much matchings coming in. The senior packages raised \$4633.86 and spent \$2340.64. The remaining money will be spent on the senior events.

Performing Arts Report: They ordered shirts for \$601.84. The NCTC is November 1st and 2nd with the conference November 8th and 9th. Poinsettias will be sold later this month by November 4th, delivered to the school December 2nd. They will be \$15, 6 ½ inch from Kings Greenhouse. The Julliard visit will be on October 31st.

Old Business: It was discussed the different places tees have been ordered from and prices were discussed. One place was Magna America and seemed a better screen quality then 2018 which faded faster. PTSO shirts will be ordered with a minimum of 12 for \$8 or \$9, one shirt color with two color logo.

New Business: Discussed doing the cookies for Walter Bickett again. Tricia had a meeting with them this week, they were really excited for it to happen again. It was asked if we were going to share this with other schools in the area and have other schools help. Renee discussed the website that her husband can design for the PTSO and it was approved for this to be a possibility with the words PTSO attached to it. Nicole and Ann will look at the PA website and do a data dump to see if it will work for our needs. The coin drive was done and one class had a large

check donated. The school will do the breakfast for the highest amount of money collected from a class and the PTSO will do something for the largest percentage of members in a first block class.

Senior Committee Report: October 3rd was the first event which was ice cream. It went over okay but don't think they will do ice cream again because of some issues. The committee has about \$400 for each event to spend. The calendar of events will be approved by Ms. Merritt and put on the counselors' page. The senior pass and signs can still be purchased at \$20 each.
