

DE Admissions Requirements

- At least 15 years old
- Currently enrolled in 11th or 12th grade at a state-approved high school or in a state-approved home school program
- On track for completing TOPS/University Core Curriculum
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- In good standing as defined by high school
- Permission from high school and parents to participate
- Meet requirements for standalone gateway English and Math (**ACT COMP 19, MATH 19, ELA 18**)
 - Course placement will be based on scores

Course Placement in Math

ACT 21+/SAT 530/ALEKS 41/ACCUPLACER 268*

- Enrollment in MATH 113

ACT 19-20/SAT 510/ALEKS 35/ACCUPLACER 250*

- Enrollment in MATH 110/113**

**MATH 110/113 – Student receives credit for MATH 113; MATH 110 is a 3-hour co-requisite course that the student will receive a grade and course credit, but it does not count towards a degree plan.

Placement into a higher math – based on ALEKS PPL Scores

- 61 - placement directly into MATH 177
- 76 - placement directly into MATH 190

Apply for Dual Enrollment

- Complete **online application** for admission for High School Dual Enrollment
- Complete **course enrollment request form (CERF)** each academic year of enrollment
- Submit **test scores** (ACT, SAT, AP, CLEP, ACCU, ALEKS)
- Submit **high school transcript**
