Notice to Parents: Student Pick-Up & Drop-Off Safety



For the safety of all students, we strongly discourage parking and picking up your child on Ventana Road. Instead, we ask that you follow the designated traffic pattern and use the school parking lot for drop-off and pick-up. If you are unable to use the parking lot, safer alternatives include the neighborhood side streets east of the school or the park next door. Please ensure that students exit and enter the vehicle on the side closest to the sidewalk.

We are actively working with the city to implement school zone lights and crosswalks, but in the meantime, please be aware that drivers often speed through this public street. Let's work together to avoid unnecessary risks and keep our students safe.
