Students can take 7 courses a year at LHS. These courses can be taken in-person, through online programs, and/or through dual enrollment. Forsyth County Schools (FCS) also allows students to add self-pay online courses to their transcript that have been taken outside of the school day. We ask that no student be penalized for taking only the maximum 7 periods allotted in their LHS schedule.

In Forsyth County Schools, students are placed on a math track in middle school, and strict guidelines govern math curriculum and prerequisites. For example, Advanced Algebra

Honors and Accelerated Geometry B/Advanced Algebra are the prerequisites for AP Precalculus, and students who have not taken AP Precalculus are recommended to take an introductory Calculus course before taking AP Calculus AB or BC. For students who do not intend to study AP Precalculus, the district offers College Readiness Mathematics, which is aligned to the CLEP College Algebra test (for which students can then earn 3 hours of

College Algebra credit). The district also offers AP Statistics as a 4th math option for students who want to attempt to earn college credit based on their AP exam score. Please do not penalize students who are not able to take an AP math course if they have taken the highest-level math courses available to them.
