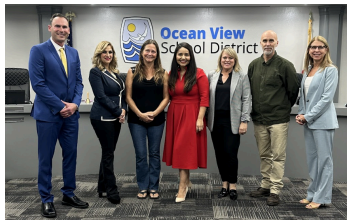

## Golden View HVAC System Update

Following the January 28 OVSD Board of Trustees' meeting, where the Board unanimously supported the staff's recommendation for a new Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditionings (HVAC) system at Golden View Elementary, the Board approved awarding the CMAS contracts to Trane U.S. Inc. for the purchase, warranty, installation, and maintenance of the new HVAC systems that will be installed in summer 2025.
