7. RESIDENT'S COMMENTS

In keeping with its philosophy of open communication and informed decision making, the BOE welcomes input from the community. The speaker shall identify themselves and confirm their residency as Seaford within the Seaford School District.

The normal time limit allotted for individual speakers shall be three minutes. The BOE may, in its discretion, decrease or increase the time allotted for individual speakers. To allow for public participation, a period not to exceed 30 minutes shall be set aside as a specific agenda item during each regular and special BOE meeting.
