## **2025 Summer Day Camp**

Come join the fun! St. James Episcopal School Summer Day Camp will keep your child entertained with a variety of fun-filled activities and learning experiences. Summer camp at St. James is a special time for children to be creative, build, explore, meet new friends and so much more! Camp will start June 9th and run through July 25th. The week of June 16th will be a 4 day week for the observance on Juneteenth on Thursday, June 19th, and the week of July 4<sup>th</sup> will be a shortened 4-day week.

We welcome ages Pre K3 (**fully potty trained - NO PULL-UPS**) through rising 2nd graders. Students that do not attend St. James School may participate in our summer camp program. We will offer a full-day camp from 8:00 – 2:30. Parents may check out our weekly camp schedule and choose which weeks they would like to attend. Camp themes will cover a broad range of interests to satisfy the growing minds of all age groups. Our campers will be taught by passionate and energetic staff who are committed to providing educational and fun opportunities for every child. **Please read all information carefully before registering your camper.**

**We will offer an early registration period for our St. James School families beginning on Monday, February 3rd. Registration for non-St. James School students will begin on Monday, March 3rd.** There is a **\$125.00** one-time, non-refundable registration fee for each camper. The registration fee reserves your spot at camp and covers supplies and a camp t-shirt. Extra camp t-shirts may be purchased for \$15.00. You will be financially responsible for registered camp sessions even if your child does not attend. Registration is required for all campers and **is not complete until the registration fee is paid and the camp packet is completed.** Packets may be picked up at St. James School Office at 860 N. **Age of Campers:** PreK3 (**fully potty trained/NO PULL-UPS**) through children entering 2nd grade in Fall of 2025.

**All** camp tuition(s) are due by May 30th. No refunds will be given for days that are paid and not attended.

Parents/guardians must sign campers in and out each day.

### **Meals and Snacks**

All campers will be responsible for their own water bottle, a nut-free morning and afternoon snack and a lunch. A catered school lunch will be offered on M, W, & F for an extra cost. All lunches are pre-ordered because our venues require us to order a week in advance.
