



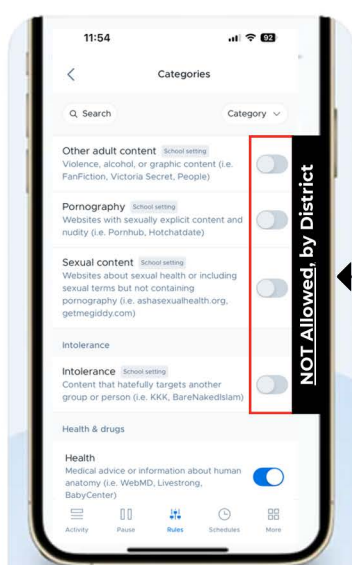
# Securly Home

Securly Home is a feature included with Madison Public School's web filtering software, giving parents control over their child's school device when it goes home, including web filtering, site restrictions, and monitored screen time. This comprehensive, easy-to-use app lets parents block additional content, view a real-time activity feed, and pause the internet from anywhere.

Securly Home only works with school-owned devices outside of school hours.

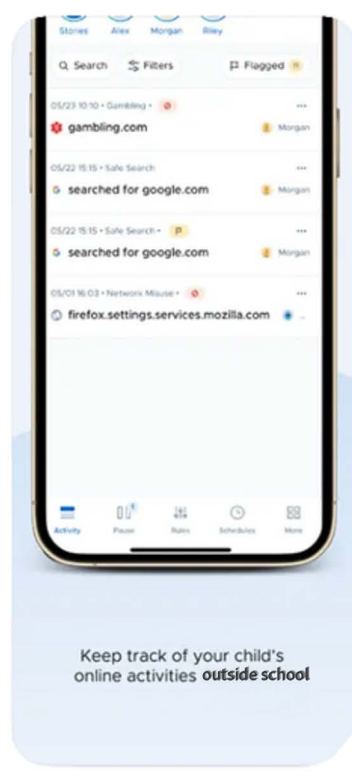
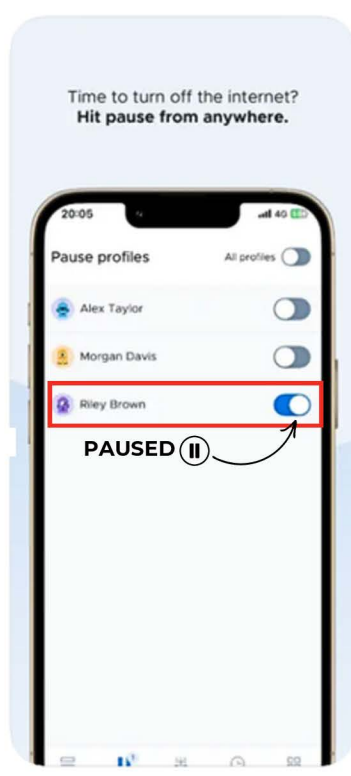
Parents can:

- Add additional rules specifically for school devices at home
- Limit screen time from anywhere with the pause button
- Schedule downtime with custom offline scheduling



NOTE: Categories blocked as a 'School Setting' cannot be re-enabled by a Parent

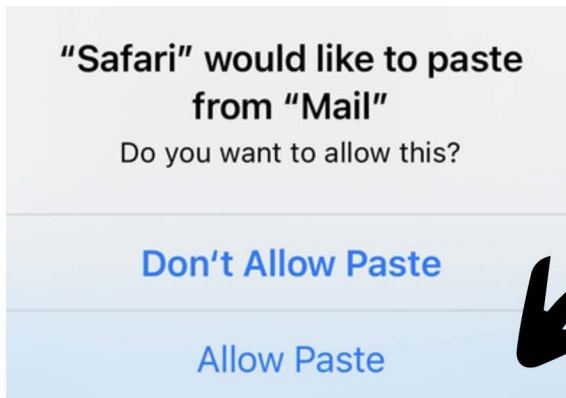
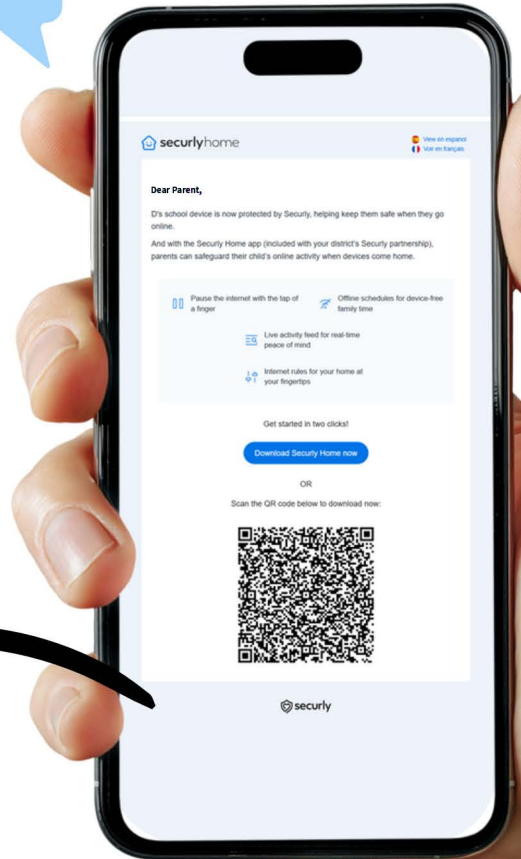

# Getting Started

Securly Home is invitation-only for Madison Public Schools. All registered Parents/Guardians will receive a link to set up Securly Home in their email (see right, for an example).

Please allow your browser to “Paste” after being directed to download the Securly Home app. Securly Home utilizes a “magic” link to your district registered email to log-in without a password.



Once logged in, Parents/Guardians can schedule offline time, add rules, and see activity from approximately the last two months for all students in their household.

## FAQ

### Can more than one Parent/Guardian control internet access via Securly?

Yes, more than one Parent/Guardian can have credentials in a household. The most recent saved setting is applied.

### Can I make the internet access less restrictive?

No, the Madison Public Schools restricted categories are for baseline safety. Parents can, however, increase restrictions to other categories or specific websites.
