Elementary Student School Climate Survey

OVERVIEW

The **Elementary Student Climate Survey** received **259 responses**, with **188 from Carnegie Elementary** and **65 from Crafton Elementary**. The feedback highlights **strong student-teacher relationships, perceptions of safety, and general satisfaction with the school environment**, while also identifying potential areas for improvement in school cleanliness and engagement with schoolwork.

STUDENT-TEACHER RELATIONSHIPS AND SUPPORT

Students largely feel supported by their teachers:

- **182 students (70%)** agree or strongly agree that **teachers and staff are fair to all students**.
- **237 students (91%)** believe that **teachers are willing to help them** when needed.

Additionally, **190 students (73%)** disagree or strongly disagree with the statement **“I wish I went to a different school,”** indicating that a majority of students are content with their school experience.

SCHOOL SAFETY PERCEPTIONS

Students report feeling safe in most areas of the school:

- **204 students (79%)** feel safe **outside around the school**.
- **201 students (78%)** feel safe in the **hallways and bathrooms**.
- **236 students (91%)** feel safe **inside their classrooms**.

These results suggest that while most students feel safe in school, **hallways and bathrooms may need additional monitoring or support** to further improve students' sense of security.

OVERALL TAKEAWAYS

The survey results indicate that **elementary students generally feel supported by teachers, safe in their classrooms, and content with their school experience**. Areas for further

exploration include **enhancing safety measures in hallways and bathrooms** and ensuring **all students feel equally treated and supported**.
