

SUNSET HILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

As part of the USD 497 School Improvement process, all district schools conduct a needs assessment and develop annual goals that are aligned with the district's strategic plan. Below you will find the 2022-23 goals for Sunset Hill Elementary School. 2022-23 Building Goals

COHESIVE CURRICULUM

Building staff will use student goal setting conferences and data notebooks to identify student data in core content subjects referred to as IPS (individual plans of study). 100% of students will have a data notebook by the end of the year, with goal check ins once a semester.

STUDENT CENTERED LEARNING

Sunset Hill staff will demonstrate 80% consistency of the learning objective, task alignment, Effective Questioning (examining DOK), and / or Kagan Strategies (academic and teambuilding) in math as measured by a minimum of one digiCoach classroom walk-through per certified teacher every month.

SAFE AND SUPPORTIVE SCHOOLS

Sunset Hill will involve parent/guardian volunteers in academic and social tasks throughout the year with a participation rate of at least 20%. This will be achieved through the volunteers playing math games, running centers, listening and practice reading tasks, academic packets, and other academic or social skill tasks. Data will be collected through a specific volunteer sign in sheet and checked at least once a quarter to view % of parent/guardian volunteer participation rate.

EFFECTIVE AND COMMITTED EMPLOYEES

Within each quarter, grade level teams will complete at least 2 PLC cycles in both Math and ELA. A PLC cycle is to include; unpacking standard, CFA and the use of a data protocol to examine student data and instructional needs. Teams will submit bi-monthly PLC agendas to the Principal and Instructional Coach as artifacts of measure.
