Westfield Summer Program is for children who reside in the Westfield Washington School District. We will be at Carey Ridge Elementary starting June 2 through July 30, 2025. The summer camp program offers fun-filled weekly activities, field trips, and guest presentations. Morning and afternoon snacks and drinks are included. No lunches will be available so please pack a lunch and drink each day for your child. Westfield Washington Schools teachers, coaches, and staff are offering multiple opportunity and sports camps. Camp descriptions and details are listed by the week in this catalog. To enroll in opportunity and/or sports camps, you will need to enroll using the Week-by-Week online enrollment. Camp dates, grades and fees can be found in each of the weekly descriptions within this catalog.

## **Plans Available & Enrollment Deadlines**

Families who are currently enrolled in TOTS, All Aboard or BAC programs must be current with their EZ ChildTrack account in order to have their summer enrollment accepted. Enrollment will be processed on a first come/first serve basis or until filled. Summer Week-by-Week Plans — Hours are 6:45 AM to 5:30 PM with the option to add opportunity and/or sports camps to your child's summer enrollment. Online enrollment will begin on March 15, 2025. Enrollment is limited.

## **IMPORTANT--Enrollment Deadlines and Cancellation Dates**

- June 2-27, 2025--Enrollment opens March 3 and cancellation deadline is May 15, 2025
- June 30-July 30, 2025--Enrollment opens March 3 and cancellation deadline is June 16, 2025

**There is a \$30 cancellation fee charged per child, per activity when cancelling enrollment prior to the cut off date. Failure to provide withdraw request via email to [mychild@wws.k12.in.us](mailto:mychild@wws.k12.in.us) by the deadline will result in your account billed the full camp fee(s).**

Summer enrollment provides the flexibility to select specific weeks from June 2 through July 30, and also includes adding opportunity and/or camps to the enrollment. These camp options are only listed in the week-by-week plans. Weekly camp descriptions with dates, times, and fees are included in this catalog. School bus transportation from full week camp to the opportunity or sports camps and back will be provided if the opportunity or sports camp is not at Carey Ridge Elementary. Your child will need to be enrolled in the full week camp in order to have this transportation.

**Extended Care Plan — Available from 5:30 to 6:00 PM. We must have a minimum of 5 enrollments each week in this plan in order to offer extended care.** If we do not reach the minimum count by the May 15 and June 16 deadlines, you will be notified shortly after the deadline dates. The extended care plan is not a stand alone plan and requires additional enrollment and weekly fees.

## **Opportunity and Sports Camps (child's grade for 2025-26 school year)**

Week-by-week enrollment also offers opportunity and sports camps only. WWS teachers, staff, and coaches are offering opportunity and sports camps beginning June 2 through July 24, 2025. All opportunity and sports camp dates, times, fees, and locations are included in the camp descriptions in this catalog. Enroll your child in just the opportunity or sports camps only or enroll in the wrap around full week camp with opportunity and/or sports camps.

# **BUS TRANSPORTATION for Grades 1 - 13 Years Old**

## **Bus Transportation for Full Week + Opportunity or Sports Camps grades 1 through 13 Years**

If your child in 1st grade through age 13 is enrolled in full week plus an opportunity or sports camp that is not at Carey Ridge Elementary, the child will receive school bus transportation to and from the full day camp site to the opportunity or sports camp.

We will follow the district guidelines regarding number of children legally allowed in a bus seat, maximum number on a bus, etc. Children who do not follow the bus rules or cause disruption, disrespect, or vandalize the bus will lose bus riding privileges for the remainder of the summer. Parents will be notified and will be responsible for any damages to property and will need to provide transportation to and from the opportunity or sports camps for the remainder of the summer. If the parent cannot provide transportation to the extra camps, the child will remain at full week camp, and the fee(s) for the opportunity and sports camp will still be charged to the account.

All children participating in camps will be dropped off and picked up at curbside with the teacher, staff, or coach out at the curb during arrival and dismissal. You will receive an email from the teacher or coach offering the opportunity or sports camp prior to the camp to provide important details about the camp, if any supplies are needed, and times / location for drop-off and pick-up.





# REGISTRATION & POLICIES

## 1st Grade Through 13 Years Old

2025-26 School Year



### Registration Fees and Payments

A \$20 per child non-refundable one-time summer registration fee will post to the account when the enrollment is accepted.

Payments: We accept credit card payments, personal checks, e-checks, or cash.

MasterCard, Visa, or Discover payments can be made through your EZ ChildTrack account. There is a 3.5% service fee for credit card payments. For your convenience, you may set up the auto-pay feature in your account using your credit card information. The system will automatically charge this card each week if a balance is due. E-checks can also be set up as autopay and there is a \$1.75 transaction fee per each e-check.

Personal checks are payable to Westfield Washington Schools and mailed to 19500 Tomlinson Road, Suite A, Westfield, IN 46074 Attn: Summer Camp. Cash payments can be dropped off at Virginia F Wood Early Learning Center, 19500 Tomlinson Road, Suite A (Door 1), Westfield, IN 46074 Attn: Summer Camp. We are open Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and closed Fridays throughout the summer.

### District Cancellation Policy

Westfield Washington Schools reserves the right to cancel any or all of the Summer program at any time due to circumstances beyond the district's control or if minimum enrollment is not received. If this occurs, parents will be contacted.

### IMPORTANT--Enrollment Deadlines and Cancellation Dates

- June 2-27, 2025--Enrollment opens March 3 through May 15; and cancellation deadline is May 15, 2025
- June 30-July 30, 2025--Enrollment opens March 3 through June 16; and cancellation deadline is June 16, 2025

There is a **\$30** cancellation fee charged **per child, per activity** when cancelling enrollment prior to the cut off dates mentioned above. Failure to provide withdraw request via email to [mychild@wws.k12.in.us](mailto:mychild@wws.k12.in.us) by the deadline will result in your account billed the full camp fee(s).

Summer enrollment provides the flexibility to select specific weeks from June 2 through July 30, and also includes adding opportunity and/or camps to the enrollment. These camp options are only listed in the week-by-week plans. Weekly camp descriptions with dates, times, and fees are included in this catalog. School bus transportation from full week camp to the opportunity or sports camps and back will be provided if the opportunity or sports camp is not at Carey Ridge Elementary. Your child will need to be enrolled in the full week camp in order to have this transportation.

Extended Care Plan — Care available from 5:30 to 6:00 PM. In order to offer this option, we must have a minimum of 5 enrollments each week. If we do not reach the minimum count by the May 15 and June 16 deadlines, you will be notified shortly after the deadline dates. The extended care plan is not a stand alone plan and requires additional enrollment and weekly fees.

### LATE PICKUP POLICY

We close at 5:30 pm. If extended care is needed from 5:30 to 6:00 pm, you must enroll in the Extended Care option. Extended care must meet a minimum of 5 weekly enrollments by the May 15 and June 16 deadlines in order to be offered. Parents will be notified shortly after each deadline date if this plan is cancelled due to inadequate enrollment.

Based on the enrolled plan, if the child is picked up after the closing time, a fee of \$1 for every minute late will be charged to the account. After two (2) late pickup charges during the summer, the fee will increase to \$5 per minute late. After five (5) late pickups during the summer, childcare will be suspended until the parent has met with the Director or Assistant Director, and all late fees have been paid. The parent will still be responsible for any remaining weekly summer fees if the child is suspended. This will be strictly enforced. Thank you for your consideration in helping our very dedicated staff. Late fees carryover from the 2024-25 school year programs, if enrolled.

# PROCEDURES for DROP OFF AND PICK UP

## 1st Grade Through 13 Years Old

### 2025-26 School Year



#### Drop off and Pick up Procedures

We will be doing curbside drop off and pick up.

- Full week camps grades 1 through 13 years old at Carey Ridge Elementary Door 4B
- Opportunity and sports camps only--You will receive an email with drop off and pick up locations and times.

Parents will not get out of the vehicle when dropping off or picking up.

You can download your family's car sign template during the online enrollment process. We will also email you a template for your family sign. Any person who is dropping off or picking up your child will need a copy of your completed sign to display on the driver's side window of the vehicle. The following information must be on your sign:

1. Each child's first and last name and 2025-26 grades. Please this information in large print.
2. A 4 digit family code that will be used for check-in and check-out. You may use any code.
3. Anyone picking up your child must have a copy of your family sign with your family code in order for the child to be released to that adult.

When dropping off, parents will follow the traffic pattern and signs to 4B for full week care (or the appropriate door mentioned in the email you will receive for opportunity or sports camps), and one of our staff will come out to your car, check the children's names and family code on your sign, then escort your children to the building.

In order to minimize delays and long lines, we ask that you be prepared and follow these directives prior to stopping at the curb:

1. Have your family sign displayed on the driver's side of the vehicle so it is easily visible from the curb.
2. Say your good-byes to your child ahead of time.
3. Unbuckle child(ren) just prior to stopping at curb.
4. All personal items (water bottle, backpack, etc.) are in the child's hands and ready to exit the vehicle.
5. All children will exit the vehicle **on the curbside onto the sidewalk from the backseat of the vehicle.**

Pick up for full day camp will also be at Door 4B (see instructions above). A staff will come out to your vehicle, check the family sign, call for the child, and assist the child to your car.

For the safety of all, we ask for your patience and cooperation during drop off and pick up. During the first week or two of camp, please allow some extra time for pick up as we anticipate delays until we all become familiar with the procedures. Parents picking up children grades 1 through 13 years must remain in their vehicle and in the car line. **DO NOT** weave in and out of the drop off or pick up line. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in keeping this process as safe and smooth as possible for everyone.

# Instructions to Set-up Account in EZ ChildTrack Grade 1 and Up

If you do not have an EZ ChildTrack account, please follow Step One instructions below first. If you have an account, proceed to the next page and follow Step Two instructions to submit summer camp enrollment.

## Step One: Instructions for Opening or Editing Your EZ ChildTrack Account

In the Westfield Summer Camp Catalog, there are important details for enrollment and withdraw dates, camp descriptions, locations, and costs. Open enrollment starts on March 3, 2025. Enroll in the week-by-week enrollment also offers opportunity or sports camps. Weekly enrollment deadlines and fees are listed in this catalog. Once enrollment is accepted, your account will be charged a \$20 non-refundable one-time summer registration fee per child.

New Families: All families who do not have an EZ ChildTrack account already setup from a prior enrollment in past Westfield summer camps, BAC, Zone 58, TOTS or All Aboard will first need to set up their online account in EZ ChildTrack. To set up the online account, click [HERE](#) to go to the EZ ChildTrack Westfield online portal to set up your account or go to <https://elc.wws.k12.in.us/programs/summer-camps> and click Enrollment. Follow the instructions below:

1. Select Register for NEW PARENT OPEN ACCOUNT. An instruction page will pop up.
2. Complete all required fields.
3. Primary Account Holder information is the parent/guardian who is responsible for the registration and billing. An email address is required and will be used for communication with the Primary Account Holder. If you do not have a home phone or a cell phone, please check appropriate box.
4. Secondary Account holder information is usually the other parent. If the other parent is not involved with the account, please check the box "Do Not Have a Secondary Account Holder". Check box to receive emails and text messages.
5. Add Child. Complete new child information including the relationship information and the child's medical information. Select the parent the child lives with in this section. This will auto-fill the child's address. In the drop-down area of the School Information field, select the school your child will attend during the 2025-26 school year and the child's 2025-26 grade level.
6. Enter at least one emergency contact (required). These are additional contacts other than the Primary and Secondary Account Holders. Do not use Primary and Secondary Account Holder information in this area.
7. You have the option of adding up to 5 additional people who are authorized to pick up your child(ren).
8. You may add any additional children to your account by clicking Add Child. If no additional children need to be added to your account, you may proceed to next step.
9. Select Terms and Conditions. Initial and electronically sign the Terms, Conditions, Release/Waivers and/or Contract Details.
10. View fees and submit application.
11. You will receive an email with your account number and a temporary password. Using this temporary password, return to EZ ChildTrack and sign in as a Returning Customer Sign In. The email associated with your account is your user name. You are now ready for the Step Two: Instructions for Online Program Registration. Call our business office at 317-896-4800 ext 14003 if you do not receive a password.

**Families with Existing Accounts:** Families with an EZ ChildTrack account from prior enrollment go to: [www.wws.k12.in.us](http://www.wws.k12.in.us) > Parents > WWS Summer Camps > Enrollment to access EZ ChildTrack and sign in under Returning Parent.

1. Forgotten User Name or Password: Do not set up a new account. Call the business office at 317-896-4800 ext 14003 to have your password reset.
2. Adding Additional Child(ren) to an existing account: If you already have an EZ ChildTrack account but need to add a child(ren), you will do this while going through the program online registration.

**Updating Account Information:** To ensure we have the most accurate contact information for your child(ren), we are asking our parents to please do the following:

1. Sign into your EZ ChildTrack account and select the My Account Tab from the home page. Review all information and updated as needed.

## Week-by-week Online Enrollment

### Step Two: Instructions for Online Summer Enrollment

- Click [HERE](#) to go to the Westfield EZ ChildTrack online portal or go to <https://elc.wws.k12.in.us/programs/summer-camps> and go to Enrollment. Sign in to your EZ ChildTrack Account under **Sign In** using your email address and password.
- Click Register for Summer 2025 for 1st Grade and Up. An instruction page will pop up for your information. Select Review Account. The program will alert you if there is an error on any of the pages.
- Primary Account Holder information will auto-fill. Review and correct all information as needed for the primary account holder. Add, review Secondary Account Holder or select "No Secondary Account Holder".
- Select Enroll after your child's name. The child's information will auto-fill. 2025-26 School and Grade will auto-fill.
- Click Review Emergency Contacts. Review and make changes if needed.
- Click Review Authorized to Pickup. Review and make changes if needed.
- Click Enter Medical Information. Review and make changes if needed.
- Click Enroll Child. Select week or weeks you want to submit enrollment for the child.
- Select the site for your child:
  - Full Week Camp Grades 1-through Age 13** (this includes Full Week Care by itself or full week with camps)
  - Sports and Opportunity Camps Only** (full day care is not included)
- Select the specific camp activity listed under each week the child wishes to enroll in. Complete each week needed before moving on.
- Click Save Enrollment.
- Select enrollment for any other children you are enrolling for summer. Repeat above instructions. If you are not registering other children on your account at this time, select "skip enrollment" under the child's name. New children may be added by selecting "Add Child".
- **IMPORTANT:** Confirm that all enrollments for the family have been submitted before continuing to Terms and Conditions. You will be unable to open Summer 2025 for any additional enrollments until all pending enrollments have been accepted by the business office.
- If you are finished, click Continue to Terms & Conditions. Each item has a link to download and read before signing. After you have read through each of them, initial and electronically sign each of the Terms, Conditions, Release/Waivers and/or Contract Details.
- Click View Fee Summary. Review the one-time \$20 per child non-refundable summer registration fee.
- Click Submit Application. You will receive an email with confirmation of registration request.
- You will receive a second email confirming enrollment in summer camps.
- After child's enrollment has been accepted, and you are now able to add more weekly summer enrollments by selecting View and Enroll. Select Register New Child if a child is not yet registered for any summer weeks.
- Summer Care for 3 and 4 year olds and 2025-26 kindergarten children is not in this section. Return to home page and select Register for Full-time Summer Care 2025 after completing and submitting registration for grades 1 and up.
- **Deadline to enroll or withdraw from activities scheduled from June 2-27 is May 15, 2025 and June 30-July 30 deadline to enroll or withdraw is June 16, 2025.** Your child(ren)'s summer enrollment will be processed within 7 to 10 business days. Acceptance of enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis and is based on each camp's availability. Enrollment will remain pending if there is a balance due on your account. Space in the summer program is not held or guaranteed if a balance is owed on an account.
- Cancellations must be received by the May 15 or June 16 deadline dates via email to [mychild@wws.k12.in.us](mailto:mychild@wws.k12.in.us). **There is a \$30 cancellation fee per child, per activity.** After the deadlines, you will be responsible for the full camp fee(s). See parent cancellation policy in this catalog.

There are no options to enroll in partial weeks or partial days for childcare.

Full week enrollment does not allow credit for days the child does not attend.
