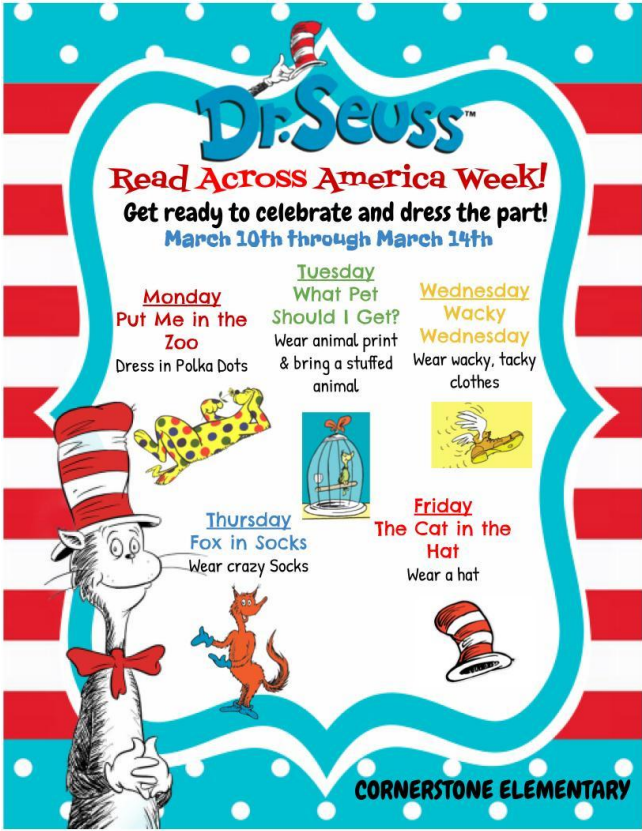

Facilities Master Plan Info

On May 6, 2025, Wooster City School District voters will decide on a bond issue to build a new middle school for grades 6-8 as part of the revised facilities master plan. This updated plan:

- ❑ Reflects community input with a \$35 million reduction from the 2023 bond.
- ❑ Addresses the need for modern learning environments for our students.
- ❑ Includes a redistricting plan for K-2 students at Kean, Melrose, and Parkview to ensure balanced enrollment, regardless of the bond’s outcome.
- ❑ Proactively plans for the future of the historic Cornerstone building, with Wooster Growth working to acquire the property.
