FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

"Let us remember that we are in the holy presence of God."

At Totino-Grace, our students learn to pray these words starting on the first day of school and continue to do so through their commencement. Not only do we pray these words together every morning as an entire school community, our teachers also pray them with our students at the start of every class period, every day. Perhaps most inspiring is when 700 students and over 60 faculty and staff members pray these words together when we gather for Mass, convocations, or other special events. Over a four year period, students will proclaim this expression over 2,200 times. Why is this important? Because these words serve as a powerful reminder of what we Catholic Lasallians are called to do: help our students to live as Jesus did, with love and compassion for all. What I further love about this phrase is that it is always true, that it can never not be true.

The Presence of God looms large at TG. It's especially poignant in the faces and voices of our students and teachers. A benefactor recently asked a freshman what he enjoyed most about TG. The young man earnestly replied, "Our teachers really like us, and I think they trust us." A great answer but not surprising to me. The benefactor then asked another question: "What don't you like about TG?" This time, the student was reluctant to share his thoughts, but with a little coaxing he finally said, "I like watching a good fist fight, but I've never seen one during my time at TG." Of all the things he could have said, this was one I couldn't have seen coming.

And while this student was only a freshman, he was already starting to understand something about Totino-Grace: that you are part of something greater than yourself at TG. We're all on the same team. As members of that team, we look out for one another. We lift each other up, we persevere through our trials, and, much



to my joy and this student's joking disappointment, we don't pick fights with one another.

We're on one team: The TG team.

The traditions of the Christian Brothers and School Sisters of Notre Dame taught us that an ethos of "community," where students feel known, welcome, and valued, is the engine that propels a TG education. Over 11,000 alumni can attest to this.

In this edition of The Continuum, you will find stories that lift up various traditions that help our students live a purpose driven life and make Totino-Grace such a special place to learn. The Christian Brothers and School Sisters of Notre Dame expected their students to do God's work; that's exactly what we continue to encourage our students to do today. Thank you for your support, prayers, and continued connection to our traditions and our school. At Totino-Grace, we are truly better together.

A THREE-GENERATION LE

For this TG family, Totino-Grace is more than just a school—it's a family legacy that has spanned three generations.

From Maureen (McManus) Brenk, class of 1977, to her daughter Kristin (Brenk) Brandl, class of 1998, and now her granddaughter Anna Brandl, class of 2027, the Totino-Grace experience has left an indelible mark on their family.

For Maureen, watching her own granddaughter walk the halls of TG is something special. "It feels amazing to be part of Anna's high school experience, so many years after our own," she says. "We always knew our kids would go to Grace, but having our oldest grandchild there makes it even more special."

Over the years, Totino-Grace has shaped the family's values and faith.

Prayer is a vital part of TG's culture, and has been handed down through all three generations of E'Gals. "We always prayed before performing, competing and for special intentions. I know that the E'gals have continued to do the same."

"The shared experience of an education at TG has kept us close," Maureen says.



Kristin shares how proud she is to continue the family tradition, both as a Totino-Grace alumna and as a coach of the E'gals. "I am very proud to be part of such a special team and grateful for the opportunity to share the experience with my mom and daughter," she says. "It feels like we have always been, and will always be, part of the E'gal community it's where we belong."

For Kristin, teamwork and community were a focus early on in life, and were reinforced by the E'Gals. "We focus on being the best contributors to the team that we can be—recognizing that being a part of something bigger than ourselves is a gift and a blessing."



While much has changed over the years, the heart of the Totino-Grace experience remains the same.

Maureen's fondest memories are numerous: "Hanging out with my friends, fall football games after school because there were no lights on the field. School dances, pepfests,

"It was just a dream that Anna could have the opportunity to dance at State for a medal. For her to win in her freshman year is truly still unbelievable."

For Anna, being part of this legacy feels like the culmination of a lifelong dream. "I have been going to E'gals competitions since I was born and have been dreaming of going to school and dancing at TG since I knew what an E'gal was," she shares. Anna's connection to Totino-Grace goes beyond just being a student—it's about carrying on a tradition that has shaped her family's values and faith for generations.

Just like the generations before, Anna sees prayer at the community's core. "The main both value and tradition



at TG that has been passed down through my family is prayer. Not only during class or before meals, but before competitions and practices as a team. I know the E'gals have been praying together for a long time, and I also know that it has had a very positive impact on our team."

The Totino-Grace experience has evolved, of course.

"Our family wouldn't be the same without the experiences we've had at TG."

Today, Anna navigates a highly competitive and constantly growing dance scene. "The sport of dance team has evolved in Minnesota to its highest point of competition yet," Anna tells us, "but due to our winning tradition and consistent coaching team, much of the TG culture has remained the same."

As the first-ever third-generation E'gal at Totino-Grace,

Anna feels both pride and responsibility. "The constant motivation of my family encourages me to become a better dancer and push for a win. Coming from a long line of state champions drives me to work harder every practice and I think it makes the team better as a whole knowing that there is such a legacy to live up to."



Having two generations of dancers to learn from, Anna told us the advice that she holds onto. "I have always been told to leave everything on the floor and to not regret my performance. I especially took this to heart at state kick finals last year when I knew everything had to be perfect and a major mistake would not be okay."

The result? "I ended up having the best performance of my



life!"

For Maureen, Kristin, and Anna, Totino-Grace is more than a high school; it's a community that bridges generations. Maureen summarizes it best: 47 years after graduating, she tells us that "the sense of community is something that we still feel every time we enter the building."

Beyond championships or accolades, what continues to connect the TG family is just that: **family.**

While most teenage boys during the 60s and 70s idolized sports figures like Harmon Killebrew or Alan Page, Tim Culbert '77 idolized Ringo Starr, the drummer for the Beatles. To say that Culbert was not the average teenage kid would be an understatement. At 6 feet, 164 pounds, Culbert was the starting linebacker on the varsity football team, not because of his size, but because of his tenacious tackling ability. He performed in all the bands and musicals, ran the hurdles, was the Grace class vicepresident and was chosen to be the senior editor of Grace High School yearbook.

Academically, Culbert flourished in the classroom. Ned Thompson, beloved math teacher, and Brother Tom, an enthusiastic biology teacher, influenced Culbert into the field of medicine where he became a pediatrician.

In the 90s, Culbert began pursuing "safe, research-based, non-drug treatments" to assist children who struggled in school and socially with their peers because of diagnoses of depression, aggressive behaviors, anxiety, or ADHD.

Culbert challenged colleagues to shift from using less "pills" to providing more "skills" for patients, such as meditation, acupuncture, music therapy, yoga, nutrition, and biofeedback. Culbert put together one of the first integrative pediatrics teams in the United States, and for ten years, Dr. Culbert coordinated team of pediatricians, psychologists, nurses, massage-therapists, acupuncturists, nutritionists, aromatherapists, and exercise physiologists as he served

as the medical director in a newly formed division called Pediatric Integrative Medicine and Pain Management Programs at the Minnesota Children's Hospitals in the Twin Cities.

In 2007, Culbert co-authored a series of books entitled "Be the Boss of Your Body" to educate children and assist families in providing sound strategies for managing sleep, pain, and stress, with Rebecca Kajander, C.P.N.P., M.P.H.

In 2017, Dr. Culbert was presented a national award from the Academy of Pediatrics for being a "Pioneer in Integrative Pediatrics".

Over the years, Dr. Timothy Culbert has kept his funloving sense of humor and many friendships with his Grace High School classmates who have become lifelong friends.

The fact that Culbert became a pediatrician does not surprise any of his friends because he always embodied the attributes of a child-a love for life, a wonder in discovering something new, and a constant desire to ask the question "why not?"

The Latest Of Dr. Culbert's Ventures: Dr. Culbert was forced to give up practicing medicine in the fall of 2023 because he was diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), commonly known as Lou Gehrig's disease. With assistance from his Grace High School linebacker buddy, Rollie Renstrom '77 and loving support from his wife Angie, he is preparing to launch a non-profit called *mentalwellnessinnovations.org* in which its mission is to provide Feel Better Packs, free of charge, to any child in the world, within days of any Adverse Childhood Experience (i.e., a humanitarian or natural disaster, or any emotional or physical trauma that produces a negative impact on a child's life). These packs will assist parents in helping their children deal with the pain and trauma of natural disasters, war, violence, or frightful diagnoses.


