PBIS-Positive Behavior Intervention Support program recognizes the positive contributions of students.

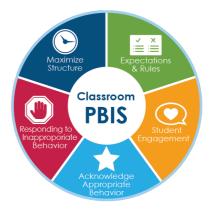
The PBIS process focuses on improving a school's ability to **teach and support the positive behaviors** of all students. The goal is to help each student develop self-discipline so they can make positive behavior choices throughout the school day.

When a school teaches the same set of PBIS expectations, all stakeholders have a **common language** to teach students the necessary behavior norms and consequences. This allows for a school environment that is **positive**, **calm**, and **conducive to learning**.

Brightwood Elementary has adopted the P.R.I.D.E. expectations. Students are taught what they look and sound like in the classroom and in common areas: arrival/dismissal, hallways, restrooms, cafeteria, bus, assemblies, and playground.

Students recite the **Brightwood Creed** each day to prepare them to be successful scholars every day!

PBIS COMPONENTS



We Teach the P.R.I.D.E Expectations

PBIS team provides teachers with lesson plans and resources that teach students about the P.R.I.D.E. expectations and how they take responsibility for their own behaviors.

We Praise & Redirect Behaviors

At Brightwood, we use Tiger Stripes as a tool for tracking student P.R.I.D.E. behaviors. Students earn tiger stripe slips for demonstrating the P.R.I.D.E expectations throughout the day.

We Communicate & Support

All parents are encouraged to join the Brightwood Elementary Dojo page as a tool for communicating with teachers!

Students can be referred for the **Paw Priase** program which offers students a daily P.R.I.D.E. expectation chart that allows for 1 on 1 feedback and goal setting with teachers. Students are rewarded for achieving daily goals and work towards consistently showing P.R.I.D.E behaviors so that they can exit the additional support program.

We Celebrate

Students who have earned specific number of points will be invited to participate in celebrations such as dance party, art activities, movie/popcorn, and water days.

We Reward

Students use the Tiger Strips earned to shop at the PBIS store for prizes such as fidgets, games, books, and other small toys.

We are thankful to any parent or community organization who would like to donate monetary funds/gift cards or provide \$1.00 toy items such as stickers, bubbles, headphones/ear pods, jump ropes etc.

- Enter and exit in a line.
- Voice level = 0.
- Remember plasticware, straws, & condiments.

R- Respect

- · Keep hands, feet, and all objects to self.
- Sit with legs under table.
- Follow directions at all times.
- · Be respectful to adults.

I- Integrity

- Voice Level = 1 or 2 while at tables and the music is off.
- Voice Level 0 when the music is on

D- Determination

Get permission to go to the restroom.

E- Excellence

- Eat your own food.
- Keep all your food & drink on your tray.
- Clean up eating area.
- Discard all eaten food & drink.



RESTROOM

BUS

As a Brightwood Tiger,

SOCIOL BUS

I will show:

P- Personal Responsibility

- Get on and off your bus ONLY at your assigned stop using only the front doors.
- Exit the bus slowly without pushing others.
- Wear and/or carry OneCard.

R- Respect

- Get to your bus stop 10 minutes before the pickup time.
- Follow the driver's instructions.
- Speak at a voice level 1 so as not to distract the driver.

I- Integrity

- Use appropriate language and gestures.
- Take care of the bus by keeping your book bag on your lap.

D- Determination

Stay in your assigned seat.

E- Excellence

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself and inside the bus.
- Sit with your bottom on the seat and your knees out the aisle.
