

## HARASSMENT, BULLYING OR DISCRIMINATION REPORTING FORM

Directions: <u>Harassment, bullying or discrimination are serious and will not be tolerated</u>. This is a form to report alleged harassment, bullying or discrimination that occurred on school property; at a school-sponsored activity or event off school property; on a school bus; or on the way to and/or from school\*, at any time when the student's behavior has a direct and immediate effect on maintaining order and discipline and protecting the safety and welfare of students and staff. If you are a student victim, the parent/guardian of a student victim, an adult relative/friend of a student victim, a student witness/bystander or a school staff member and wish to report an incident of alleged harassment, bullying or discrimination, complete this form and return it to the principal, assistant principal, teacher or counselor at the student victim's school. Contact the school for additional information or assistance at any time.

Harassment, bullying and discrimination are defined as conduct intended to intimidate, discredit, injure or disturb a student or groups of students to the extent that the behavior causes mental and/or physical harm to students and is sufficiently severe, persistent and pervasive so that it creates a learning environment that is intimidating, threatening or abusive. Harassment, bullying and discrimination can occur face to face, in writing or through use of electronic means such as the internet, emailing or text messaging. Cyberbullying can include the use of personal web sites to support deliberate, repeated and hostile behavior intended to cause harm to persons or groups.
