High School Office Info

When school is in session, the High School office is open Monday-Friday between 6:45am-3:45pm.

When arriving, press the bell button by the main doors under the large ENTRANCE sign, and we will unlock it for you to come in.

Raptor- Visitor Check-in

ALL visitors need to present a drivers license or state ID to be run through the District's security Raptor check when entering the main office. Once you are checked in, you will receive and must wear a Raptor visitor sticker visibly on the upper front part of your body. (It is a white sticker that has a black & white photo from your driver's license, and includes the word Visitor across the top) After your visit, please return to the main office to return the sticker and be signed out.

Visitor parking is in the front row and please DO NOT park in a numbered spot. You will need to register your vehicle in the office when checking in, so please memorize or take a picture of your license plate before entering the building.

Lunch Account Balance Information

Students will be permitted to purchase meals from the District's food service using either cash on hand or a food service account. A student may be allowed to incur a negative food service account balance subject to the following conditions.

Students may be permitted to accumulate negative food service account balance as determined by the District Administrator. The District Administrator shall determine the manner of determining permissible account balances by grade level. A student shall not be permitted to purchase a la carte items without sufficient account balance or cash on hand.

Students that are receiving free or reduced price meals will be permitted to purchase a USDA approved meal if the student has the necessary funds with him/her to purchase the meal, regardless of whether the student has a negative account balance.

This policy and any implementing guidelines shall be provided in writing to all households at the start of each school year and to households transferring to the school or School District during the school year. The policy and implementing guidelines will also be provided to all District staff with responsibility for enforcing the policies. The policy and guidelines will be posted on the District website.

High School Calendar Push Notifications

Many of you have noticed that we have many great activities happening at our school daily. We recognize this can make finding what you are most interested in difficult. If you are interested in setting push notifications for specific high school activities, please follow the instructions below.

- 2. On the right side of the screen, under the calendar, click on the Notify Me tab.
- 3. If you haven't created an account, you will be prompted to create one so the system knows where to send the push notifications.
- 4. Once your account is set up, you will be asked to choose the activities you are interested in receiving push notifications for.
- 5. Once your notifications are set, choose when you would like to receive the notifications and click save.

You are all set. Revisit the calendar to adjust your notifications as needed.

Hope Squad

Hope Squad is a school-based peer support team, made up of students who are nominated by their peers, that partners with local mental health agencies. Research shows that children and young adults who are contemplating suicide are more likely to reach out to their peers than the adults in their lives. In this way, Hope Squad members are the "eyes and ears" of the school building – monitoring for warning signs of suicide



and helping to connect their peers with staff members who can offer the appropriate resources in times of need. The Unified School District of De Pere has Hope Squad teams at Foxview, DPMS, and DPHS.

Teens can obtain a permit in WI at age 15.

- Teens will not be allowed to apply for their probationary license until they are at least 16 years old, hold their permit for at least 6 months ticket free, practice hours of at least 50 hours and 10 of those at night, and have completed all of driver education (classroom and BTW lessons).
- Another change is that the **permit will be good for 18 months** instead of 12 months. All 16-17 year olds **will have to take the road test.**
- The new law changes the number of practice hours required during the permit phase, it changed from **30** hours to **50** hours. The DMV does not collect the practice driving record when teens go for their road test however they may ask to see it or the **Road Ready app** which also tracks practice time.
- Your teen should work toward at least 100 hours of practice with 30 of those at night based on national
 recommendations put forth by AAA Foundation research in order to give novice drivers more experience
 before licensing (shows it reduces crashes after licensing). Our common goal for everyone is to have
 fewer crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving teens and all other drivers. Use of the Road Ready app is
 a great tool for them to track their progress of practice hours.

Who is eligible to enroll? Any student who is 14 years/10 months to 18 years old. Sign up information is located on the De Pere High School webpage under the "Students" tab under the Driver's Education link. Aurora BayCare Offers Student-Athlete Sports Physicals at DPHS

On **Monday, April 14** and **Monday, May 19**, Aurora BayCare Sports Medicine will offer comprehensive sports physical exams at De Pere High School for students currently in Grades 6-11.

Appointments will be scheduled every 15 minutes, beginning at 5:30pm. Allow 30-40 minutes for the appointment.

The appointment will include a full health screening by a physician or physician assistant, a vision exam, and evaluation for ACL injury risk. This physical will meet school and WIAA requirements for the 2025-26 and 2026-27 school years. A parent or guardian must accompany the student, or sign a parent consent form.

Cost is \$25. All proceeds will be donated by Aurora to De Pere athletics.

Policy for Admission of Youth Booster Club Basketball Players to High School Games
