 - TELPAS (Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System): We have completed approximately three weeks of this test. We are catching the students who were absent during testing.
 - TSI (Texas Success Initiative): We will test all students Wednesday, March 5, 2025 who have not passed this college entrance exam. This powerpoint What is TSI? will be shared with child(ren) Monday, March 3, 2025 so they learn more about the test and its importance. Students who have passed the TSI will participate in post secondary rotations.
