## Nursing Assistant Certificate

Once the students complete the Nursing Assistant 1 program and pass additional background checks, they will be ready to take the Oregon State Board of Nursing Nursing Assistant 1 exam. Pass the exam, and they earn their Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA 1) license!
