Monitor (updates made)

Kindergarten of the 5 students in red, only 2 are still in red, 1 green, and 2 blue.

1st grade - 3 students were yellow at BOY and 2 are now red and 1 is yellow. There were no red students.

2nd Grade 4 students started in red, 3 are still in red and 1 is in yellow.

3rd Grade 6 students started in red, MOY 4 are in red, 2 are yellow. 5 started in Yellow, MOY 1 is red, 2 green, 2blue.

4th grade- BOY 1 red/MOY 1 red. 1 yellow/MOY 1 GREEN.

5th Grade BOY 5 Red/MOY 4 red. BOY 5 Yellow/MOY 1 red, 4 yellow.

NWEA Math overall for all grades, our achievement average is 73rd percentile. Our growth average is 46th percentile.

Today grade levels met on MOY data in SPS meetings to analyze student data and determine what additoinal steps need to be taken, what was working and what wasn't.

Mrs. Sluder shared on behalf of Mrs. Topolka a suggestion of using a data wall to track student data.

Mr. Kelly suggested a data wall on excel that could be utilizes and tracked digitally that saves the time of cutting, laminating, making a wall that continually changes.

Mrs. Friesen and Carter suggested having grade level goals on the walls as opposed to individual student data.

Mrs. Friesen shared that her and Mrs. Fox will be utilizing student data notebooks.

Staff brainstormed how we would utilize a Data Wall on excel and what it should include. Teachers suggested growth, goals, groups and data tracked across all grade levels for all students.

We will look at AG student growth and analyze, assess, and determine how to grow these students.

We dissed a vision of a long-term goal that make schoolwide data notebooks, and eventually student led conferences including students show casing work they are proud of and mini data chats.

A4.06- We are implementing our morning meetings, common area expectations, etc.
