Grade levels shared what they have done in the past...

Kinder usually plays a lot of games with nonsense, sight words, competitions with sight word wars, and various hands on activities.

1st and 2nd usually have a lot of relays, flash activities, tenzies, outside activities, they also leveled their questions so that all could participate. Classes have a theme and they use that to create activities.

4th usually has a reading and math packets. They answer the first question and go to the teacher to earn a tally point and maybe some candy. Each point leads to bigger prizes as they go along.

5th usually has a theme with a variety of hands on activities with incentives. They have a theme songs, group activities...

Mrs. Schaeffer created a Mock EOG in each area for teachers to use with students last year. She asked the team if they would like to have a designated day to have a mock testing day so that we can use the data to drive our book camp. The week of April 29 is the week to consider for this activity.

Mrs. Garcia suggested that we have a DIBELS assessment team in place at the beginning of next year to support our teachers, students and school.
