Lawful Absences in the State of North Carolina

The state of North Carolina has determined that these absences will be excused.

- Illness or injury preventing the student from being physically able to attend school.
- The Local health officer or the State Board of Health orders the isolation of the student.
- Death of a member of the immediate family.
- A Medical or dental appointment.
- Religious Observances
- The student obtains **prior approval** from the Principal to take advantage of a valid educational opportunity such as travel.
