D1.02-Resource Allocation as active indicators in NCStar. Team reviewed Resource Allocation admin team updated.

Action Taken:

Arts Education Week-- next week is Arts Education Week. The following was suggested from the arts department as a spirit week. Neese motioned to approve. Pence seconded. Team approved doing this next week.

Review bylaws-- team reviewed bylaws to determine if revisions were needed; SLT guidelines require us to review annually. Team moved to keep as they are for this year. Neese motioned to approve as they are for

this year. Pence seconded. All agreed.

Elect 2024-2025 chairperson- bylaws call for chairperson to be elected annually. Peeples asked for nominations or volunteers. C. Moore said she would be willing to serve in the role. Neese motioned; Carpenter seconded. The team agreed.

Proposed budget transfer: \$1300 from Title I (EEA) and \$1275.21 from Restart (supplies) to field trips in those respective budgets. Pence explained that we need headphone adapters for the testing headphones we just bought. Moore moved that we leave the Restart supply line and use those funds for the adapters and to move the \$1300 in Title I from EEAs to field trips-- with benefits the amount is \$1711.97. Pence seconded. All approved.

MTAC-- training and device policy; Pence reviewed with the team that the SLT serves as the MTAC team as well. She reviewed the challenged book process in case we ever have a challenged book. Then, the team discussed a device policy for devices broken and inappropriate use. Team discussed a warning letter and documentation in Educator's Handbook for a first offense. The subsequent offenses would still be in Educator's Handbook and a limitation of device usage for 30, then 60 then 90 days. Pence will draft a letter for the next meeting

SIP-- more info coming at Principals Meeting about SIP goals; worked to draft action steps to show how resources/funds are being spent

FAM-S priority items: 21, 26, 27-- team discussed these priorities as they align with the school agreed upon priorities from our NC DPI unpacking in August-- relationships, effective strategies, data driven focus; Curtis motioned to have these three as FAM-S focus area. Neese seconded. All approved.

Celebration of Excellence-- no one has stepped forward to coordinate being in the spirit parade. We will work to get as many as possible to attend-- wear this year's Cone shirt with optional cougar ears, tails, face paint
