Action Taken:

- Science night-- will do as part of May 12 curriculum night; kits from Duke Energy; Ms. Parker and Mr. Crouse, intern, will help with the science part. Ms. Atkinson and Dr. Rooks said they'd coordinate the night overall. Would like to have specialists also help run some field day type of activities.
- Cafeteria-- now that mask optional, grade levels were split about returning to eating in the cafeteria; after discussing logistics (including aspects like having to change custodial schedules), we opted to stay eating in rooms; we can tie eating in the cafeteria to some of the Tier 1 and 2 PBIS and Attendance celebrations, potentially; after we met, we got word from Food Services that they have to clean between groups still, so really, returning is not an option right now.
- Discipline data review for February-- Dr. Rooks shared; Monday and Thursday are the days with
 the most referrals, and from 10-12. Classroom continues to be the main area, and at
 transitions. Discussed how/when majors are converted to minors, and where to access the
 behavior matrix. The LiveBinder for PBIS is linked in the Staff Handbook in the StaffNotebook.
 Ms. Gladstone is also working with the MTSS team (MTSS focuses on academics, behavior,
 attendance) to revisit these and the PAWS matrixes in light of Mask Optional guidance now. Dr.
 Rooks encouraged team to have people check with admin who assigned consequences if there
 are questions/concerns.
