Reflect on progress

INITIAL DATA SUGGESTS: Reading-- 19% proficiency/gain of 6%; Math-- 13% proficiency/loss of 1%; Science-- 17% proficiency/gain of 3%; initial growth data shows growth in 3-5 reading EOG-- average of 7.6; 4-5 (3rd doesn't factor in growth) math EOG-- average of 5.95. Science a loss of 10.9. Overall school composite appears to have shifted from 15% to 17%. SIP goal was a 5% increase.

<u>Thoughts</u>: This year SS was a non-negotiable which took time from science at some grade levels. We need more hands on and scenario based lessons again. We need to make use of Education Galaxy and STEMScopes from day 1. We have K-4 LEGO Kits to use a well. Could we have any of the tutors be science specific this year?

ATTENDANCE:

Last year our Tier 2 and 3 was 58% (29.4% Tier 3; 28.6% Tier 2)

This year Tier 2 and 3 is 50.6% (21.3% Tier 3; 29.3% Tier 2)

<u>Thoughts</u>: We should start on the incentives day 1 (which we have planned to do). PAWS cart helped-will start in cafeteria next year since being back in the cafeteria is a new thing for them. Asked if truancy will come back into place? We don't know yet.
