Action Taken:

- Family Night-- about 20 stations that focus on science; station of K registration; station for lunch application, then get box meals and exit; all is laid out; each science project will be done 3 times so families know when to rotate to a new station; science boards available in Dr. Rooks' office if the groups would make one to advertise their station; tried to pair station captains across levels to help with the community feel; reminders have been sent out; all certified are expected to be there (5:00-7:00); classified are invited; Title I survey will be done at the end as well; most stations are outside; the BOGO book fair is not happening due to media transition; see or email Dr. Rooks, Ms. Atkinson, Ms. Parker, or Mr. Crouse if there are questions/concerns.
- Awards days-- suggestions of awards NWEA growth awards, Reading or Math SPARK Award-- if they have a positive trend line with at least 2 data points this year) awards, Cougar Paw award (reward those who behaviorally have done what they are supposed to-- at least 80% or higher positive Dojo for the year); Principal's Cougar Award-- at least 97% or higher positive Dojo for the year, specialists'/SEL awards-- Golden Paintbrush (art), and pick an award per area (all 4s); Highest Growth (reading, math, science-- grades, interims, tests, etc.); CONEsistent Cougar Award (consistent effort with Academics, Behavior, Attendance); 3-5 Honor Roll for FINAL grade (do in the classroom)--- READ/RECOGNIZE in ABC order so difference in classes % of honor roll is not so apparent); have all teachers on team up at one time to award each category together (Neese likely has a run of show); any other awards can be given in the class; will 5th sing a song? Music teacher helped them practice/sing; invites will be sent
