A Leadership Team will consist of the principal, teachers who lead the Instructional Teams, and B1.03 other professional staff meets regularly (at least twice a month) to review implementation of effective practices.(5137)

Monitor (updates made)

- Reviewed interim data (per SIP goal):
- 1. By June 2019, Cone Elementary School will increase our reading composite from 18.2 to 20.2. 3rd grade reading from 20.2 to 22.2; 4th grade reading from 17.1 to 19.1; 5th grade reading from 17.1 to 19.1. We are on track for this goal based on our multiple measures, including how many students are moving proficiency bands (56 in ELA)—if this 27% increases proficiency on the EOG, we are on track with our goals. If we average the 3 interims, we'd have 41% correct in 3rd, 40% in 4th, and 47% in 5th.
- 2. By June 2019, Cone Elementary School will increase our math composite from 27.5 to 29.5. 3rd grade from 35.7 to 37.7; 4th grade from 19.5 to 21.5; and 5th grade from 19.5 to 21.5. We are on track for this goal based on our multiple measures, including how many students are

moving proficiency bands (24 in math)—if this 11% increases proficiency on the EOG, we are on track with our goals. If we average the 3 interims, we'd have 49% correct in 3rd, 45% in 4th, and 45% in 5th.

- 3. By June 2019, Cone Elementary School will decrease the amount of instructional time lost due to behavior incidents. We have decreased referrals and time out of class by 50% from YTD August-December 2017 to YTD August-December 2018. As of 4/4/2019 we had 122 incidents in PowerSchool. Of those, 81 had ISS consequences and 10 had OSS consequences. Physical aggression and fighting continue to be our most frequent offenses.
- 4. By June 2019, Cone Elementary School will increase the growth of our Black students to at least 0.0 or above (meet expected growth).
 - • 5th—27%/65%/62% yellow/green on ELA IA1/2/3, 38%/42%/58% yellow/green on Math IA1/2/3. We are on target to make expected growth with 5th grade.
 - • 5th Science—28%/23%/82% IA1/2/3. We need to put more support in 5th science.
 - • 4th—35%/43%/50% on ELA IA1/2/3; 42%/45%/56% on Math IA1/2/3. We are on target with 4th grade.
 - • 3rd—30%/44%/60% on ELA IA1/2/3; 58%/52%/58% on Math IA1/2/3. We are on target with 3rd grade.
- 5. By June 2019, Cone Elementary will increase our Science proficiency from 42.9 to 44.9.
- 5th Science—40% on interim 1; 32% on interim 2; 62% interim 3. An average of the 3 interims is 46% correct. We had 43 (60%) move proficiency bands from interim 1 to 3. We need to keep more support in science. We are going focusing on vocabulary more specifically and enhancing reading support to help assure students can read the tests correctly via daytime tutors and the Level Up Academy (after school tutoring with target students). We added a science special 2-21-19 for grades 3-5th to intensify exposure to science.

Discussed allotments:

- Overall holding steady with what's been the status: 24 classroom teachers, 1 preK and TA, 1 EC preK and TA, 4 TAs, 3 specialists, 1 technology assistant, 1 office support/data manager, 1 treasurer, 1 social worker, 3 MCL II (no III next year)-- 1 per level 3, 4, 5, 1 CF, 1 EC TA, 3 EC teachers, AG .4
- Title I less about \$87,000 from last year
- Priority funding is discontinued (we are off the priority list)
- Restart funding will be about what we had this year, though amounts haven't been shared yet
- Will look to add an Social Emotional Learning team to help with students: an additional counselor (Restart funded), a Youth Development Coordinator (local and Title I funded). If more money becomes available once budgets are finalized, we will add a behavior support TA.

Discussed School Based Mental Health services that Cone will have starting this year and through

2019-2020 school year. Will have more details soon.
