 - A.4.06 All teachers are attentive to students' emotional states, guide students in managing their emotions, and arrange for supports and interventions.(Rickard)
 - Discipline data update Discipline data was reviewed

- Team reviewed informal administrator's discipline file; 176 referrals with physical aggression being primary infraction.
- Around 40% under last year's referral count. This year's goal was to
- 102 ISS; 27 OSS resulting from referrals
- ISS has decreased from last year; OSS up by one from where we ended last year, but all but one resulted from physical aggression
- 148 Restorative Practice referrals (104 Rule 6/8; 42 physical aggression (horse playing etc.)
- Office referrals by quarter; 3rd quarter was our lowest of all three quarters; Restorative Practice referrals continue to increase
- 4th grade continues to be highest, but showing a decrease since departmentalization; 3rd grade also a higher number.
- Official district discipline results has not been released.
- All indicators show we are on target to meet our goals.
- o School Restart & Allotment Process Update & Review
 - Restart if approved by the board will give a lot of options and flexibility.
 - Many more information will be coming if Board approves and once allotments are finalized.
