- Recent Successes~
 - **Significant # of transitional students reached level P on MOY**
 - **Two 2nd grade class had 100% on math post-assessment test on geometry (attributes and shapes)**
 - **4th grade schedule adjustment is going well; Teachers**
 - **Feb. CKLA visit went well. Coach likes how teachers added their own teaching style (flair) within the CKLA framework.**
- Coaching Comments ~ **Dr. March appreciated attending Leadership and reviewing performance data**
- Old Business
 - A.4.06 All teachers are attentive to students' emotional states, guide students in managing their emotions, and arrange for supports and interventions.(Rickard)
 - **Discipline data update - Discipline data was reviewed**
 - **Data was reviewed from Aug 1 - Jan. 31st with comparison to last year; data shows referral down 44.4% and loss of instruction are down 36.9%**
 - **Explanation that rule 6/8 are disrespect, noncompliant, walking out etc.**
 - **Most referrals coming from physical aggression and fighting**

- **Cone's behavior report through March 1st shows 278 total referrals (Restorative Practice referrals = 113 and Office referrals = 165 (bus referrals roughly 1/5 of referrals (24) with 3 students having multiple referrals)**
- **Physical aggression office referrals: 15 kids have 3 or more aggressions (with highest referrals per 1 student = 7)**
- **Mr. Reid has started boys group with 4th grade boys with multiple referrals and can develop into big brothers for the next year**
- A1.07 All teachers employ effective classroom management and reinforce classroom rules and procedures by positively teaching them. (McCain)
 - **CHAMPS training – 2 teachers attended CHAMPS training**
