- SIP Initiatives Reflection & Feedback

- A2.04 Instructional Teams develop standards-aligned units of instruction for each subject & grade level. (Steele)

**PLCs are rolling smoothly; data protocols are being filled out and uses the data to guide instruction**

- A4.01 The school implements a tiered instructional system that allows teachers to deliver evidence-based instructional aligned with the individual needs of students across all tiers. (Steele)

- **Progress check mtgs. Begin next week; teachers are asked to reflect on BOY data to be intentional on which students really need a higher tier of interventions. Students previously served by LLI teachers are a great place to start since they have already received a tiered level of intervention.**

- D2.01 All teachers use online, hybrid, or blended learning as part of a larger pedagogical approach that combines the effective socialization opportunities w/in the classroom w/ the enhanced learning opportunities available through technology. (Neese)

**5<sup>th</sup> grade using modules, blended learning going well and implemented throughout the day; Mastery Pathways is providing some difficulties; reaching out to Sabrina Jenkins for assistance with moving mastery pathways to Commons. 4<sup>th</sup> grade beginning to implement based on technology they currently have.**

**New gradebook (Power Teacher Pro) training happened by Neese; want it rolled out by January with additional people trained for schools piloting it. 5<sup>th</sup> grade will wait until 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter for training and implement it. (Ms. Jenkins will open up a Canvas course for training.)**

- B3.01 The LEA/school monitors progress of the extended learning time programs & strategies being implemented and uses data to inform modification (Weikart)

**44 walk-throughs completed; quality of tasks to the standard 60-65% tasks are aligned; would like to see more critical thinking, rather than repeating procedural focus. Most are near to 4:1 in redirections and uses Capturing Kids' Heart signals.**

- C2.01 The LEA/school regularly look at school performance data and aggregated classroom observation data and uses that data to make decisions about school improvement and professional development needs (Weikart)
