## Looking to schedule this in the spring

- A4.06 Attentive to students' social & emotional states
  - Diamonds & Pearls update ~has met 2x's; 12 fifth grade girls; couple activities lined up between now and winter break
  - Men of Training- 8 young men signed up from 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>.; Steele talked from A&T social justice to come help volunteer; part of M.I.T with schedules in January;
  - Discipline referral update ~ data current through Thanksgiving in SWIS 121 office referrals w/ about 48 = 5<sup>th</sup>; 22 in 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>; 11 in 2<sup>nd</sup>; 17<sup>th</sup> in 4<sup>th</sup>, 1 in Kindergarten
  - Decrease in Nov referrals; lowest since August.
  - Physical aggression highest referral behav.
    (42) with disruption (38) second highest
    (disrespect decrease from last year)
  - 71 ISS out of 42 students throughout 88 days of instruction
  - 3 kids OSS for 6 events throughout 6 days of instruction
  - 15 students have 3 or more referrals for 62 of our office referrals. (out of around 460 total enrollment)

## • New Business

- o Math fact automaticity focus-
  - Literacy is measured in many different ways between DIBELS and TRC;
  - Research shows students who don't know math facts, don't maintain their stamina to complete the problems because so much brainpower is needed for computations
  - What do we have that can predict and track our students' scores for EOGs? What can we do to have our 5<sup>th</sup> graders by end of the year to know their multiplication and division?
  - Ideas about CBM's or timed tests to help monitor students' progress.

- Time for vertical alignment to create continuum to share across the school to help push students along
- Vertical conversation occurs during faculty meeting.
- Create a team to plan more concretely and will come back to share with Leadership.
- Budget updates
  - Title 1 money needs to be spent by mid/end of January;
    Approximately 95% has been spent from our Title 1
    budget.
