- Think About which format we would prefer
  - Extended Learning for EOG push will happen last 5 weeks prior to EOG for 2x a week
  - Saturday academy ~ student attendance was about the same in both formats; could involve teachers from around the academy; will have to set aside around \$500 for food \*\*Steele will talk with testing grade teachers for their input preferences for Extended Learning or Saturday Academy. Team is okay to table

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o Review of budget

- Reviewed account ledger in general terms. We are waiting to see if lower allotment will adjust our money amounts; instructional money will be adjusted with 60 less students than projected.
- New Business
  - o Staffing adjustments
    - 60 kids under projection. Supposed to lose 3 position, but we are only losing 2.
    - About to embark on significant shift; losing 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 4<sup>th</sup> classrooms; will create a 5<sup>th</sup> grade classroom; principal decision made on this (making best on less than desirable situation)
      - Currently close to state cap with 5<sup>th</sup> grade with three classrooms.
      - Didn't make growth by .02 last year
      - ARC materials will shift from 4th to 5th.
      - Hope to know transition plan and shift by tomorrow afternoon.
      - Monday 9/19/16 PLC to focus on adjusting class rosters
      - Tuesday will notify parents with a letter and Connect-Ed message will go out.
      - 2,3,4 will start with new classrooms on Wed. teachers making adjustments will have time to make move and new focus.
      - New 5<sup>th</sup> grade class and people in new role will start on Monday, Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>. Important to remain positive and optimistic.
      - Specialists will all remain; additional blocks for specialists will be interventionists with grade levels.
