- O Title 1 Plan update/revisions Slight adjustment to Title 1 plan due to adjustments in salaries (about \$7000); still getting everything asked for; adjusting \$6000 to \$5000 with fieldtrips; little off technology and little off supplies because enrollment is lower than expected.

- o Plan A4.01 ~ The school will implement a tiered instructional system that allows teachers to deliver evidence-based instruction aligned with individual needs of students across all tiers.
 - Mentoring Minds agreed to purchase for grades 1 5; still looking for appropriate K resource
 - Accelerated Reader ~waiting for renewal, students take STARS test; will adjust testing period to 3 nine weeks and window will close before EOGs. This will help minimize too much conflict with other award ceremonies, PBIS celebrations etc.
 - Achieve 3000~ 3rd graders only
 - needs assessment for IE or other supplies~ grade levels have \$583 to purchase materials to help students with reading and math
