PERFORMANCE GOALS FOR 2019

- I. By 2019, Foust Elementary School will increase overall performance composite from 40% in 2018, to 41.4%
- II. By 2019, Foust Elementary School will increase 3rd grade reading proficiency from 37.1% in 2018 to 38.7%.

FIRST SEMESTER DATA

- I. ELA Benchmark Scores
 - a. 3rd – ranked 31/70
 - b. 4th – ranked 44/72
 - c. 5th – ranked 60/72
- II. MATH Benchmark Scores
 - a. 3rd – ranked 40/70
 - b. 4th – ranked 48/72
 - c. 5th – ranked 48/72
- III. Discipline Referrals
 - a. 1st quarter = 4 (decreased by 5 from 2018)
 - b. 2nd quarter = 2 (decreased by 15 from 2018)
- IV. DIBELS Composite Data for MOY
 - a. K = 55% proficient (increase from 31% at BOY)
 - b. 1 = 46% proficient (increase from 37% at BOY)
 - c. 2 = 52% proficient (decrease from 61% at BOY)
 - d. 3 = 64% proficient (decrease from 70% at BOY)
- V. TRC Composite Data for MOY
 - a. K = 12% proficient (decrease from 45% at BOY)
 - b. 1 = 24% proficient (decrease from 37% at BOY)
 - c. 2 = 60% proficient (increase from 57% at BOY)
 - d. 3 = 51% proficient (decrease from 55% at BOY)

**Teachers will create anchor charts and question stems to aid with building vocabulary and enhancing student responses to higher order comprehension questions. These will be shared with specialists, tutors and ESL teachers to ensure all students will be challenged when completing comprehension activities.
