III. Review and respond to coaching comments

- o On November 3rd, in your action steps you emphasized a plan to discuss data in PLCs. How are you using the data? Do you see teaching and learning goals?
- I see in your interim data that there is a 10 percentage point gap between ALL students and AA students. Who are these students? What can you do in order to decrease this gap? What is your gap you white students and your black students?
- 5th grade science is another area in which there is larger gap between ALL students and AA students. The gap in 9% points. What is the gap between your white students and your black students in 5th grade science?
- As a science and technology magnet, I would expect your science scores to be higher. Based on the scores I had at the time I am writing this, your school ranked 6th, which is good, but not best. What kind of school-wide initiative can you put in place to assure that all students have all the science vocabulary they need to grasp and understand science concepts?
- Who are the students who are not scoring as high as others? What learning opportunities can you provide them in order to enhance both their learning and their scores?
- Thank you for your hard work. Synergy and teamwork will be the answer for General Greene to soar.
- Ms. Harris' reply: We are using the data to dig deeper to understand students' needs to remediate and accelerate instruction for students. We will continue to look at the gap among our black and white students and plan next steps to ensure student growth. This will be discussed at our upcoming GLT.

Education Galaxy Usage

- Subscription runs out in January.
- Grade level reps needed to share out regarding their usage and apps they are using instead: K is not using as much as they used to; 1st only one teacher is using Ed. Galaxy; 3rd it is used some in ELA; 4th none of the teachers are using it; 5th Ralston is using it with Zearn and Karl is using it in science while working with small groups. Lambillotte shared that this is a great tool for students to learn online test taking strategies such as highlighting the text.
