# Coming Up!

**Forward Testing:** Wisconsin students in Grades 6-8 will be participating in the Wisconsin Forward Exam this Spring. James Madison students are scheduled to take the Forward assessment between March 17, 2025 and April 25, 2025, with the majority of our students testing between April 3-10, 2025, after spring break. Students will not be testing on all days during this testing window. There are designated days for each grade level to take specific portions of the overall state assessment. Please ensure your student has a pair of working headphones for this assessment and reach out if you need assistance with this. 
