Our daughter Roxie started attending Gateway Education Center after we moved to Greensboro in 2014 when she was 11 years old. At this time she was struggling with severe developmental delays. She was unable to walk, had limited communication, had suffered through years of epilepsy, and had difficult behavior challenges. At Gateway Roxie received physical, occupational, and speech therapies regularly and was in a specialized learning environment which allowed her to participate in the classroom and school activities. As her parents we were comforted knowing that the faculty and staff at Gateway are trained and experienced to respond to a seizure, other health problems, or behavioral challenges. Soon after moving to Gateway Roxie began to change and grow in ways we had begun to doubt were possible. As the months and years went by, Roxie's disruptive behaviors decreased and she began to love being in the classroom, interacting with her peers and teachers at Gateway. Physically she also blossomed, learning to walk at age 12 and she continues to learn to communicate in her own way. Roxie would not be the strong, happy, and capable young woman she is today if she had not been at a school like Gateway. We are grateful that Gateway Education Center exists to serve the needs of children like Roxie in our community.
