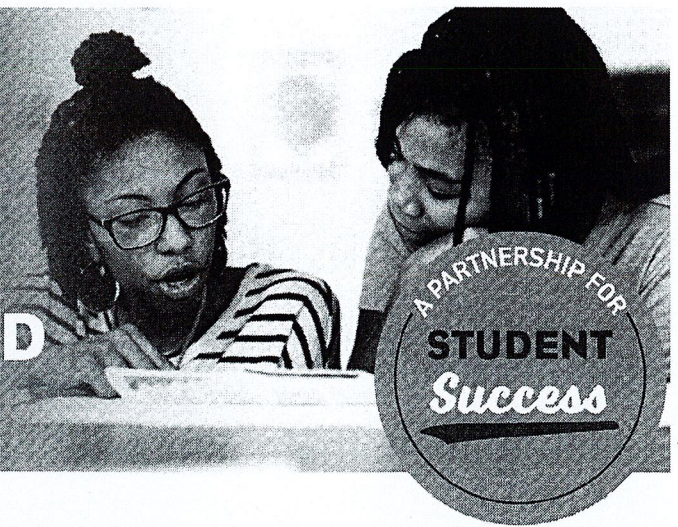


2024-25 SCHOOL-PARENT AND FAMILY COMPACT
