Overview



Homebound Defined

- Homebound services are for students who will be confined to home or hospital for a minimum of four weeks during the school year for medical or psychological reasons only.
- The weeks do not have to be consecutive for services.
- Students in non-residential treatment facilities are NOT eligible for homebound services.
- Homebound is not an alternative school option or for students who are struggling with the traditional school setting without a medical psychological diagnosis requiring confinement.
- Homebound is the MOST restrictive environment for students.

Homebound Process

- 1. Request can be initiated by parent or staff
- 2. Complete documentation from a medical doctor
- 3. 504 & ARD meetings held prior to service implementation
- 4. Eligibility determined by committee
- 5. Services & Supports determined by committee
- 6. Teacher notification & communication established
- 7. Identify teacher and verify credentials

Homebound Committee should include...

- 1. A Campus Administrator
- 2. A Teacher of the Student
- 3. A Parent or Guardian of the student



Homebound Accommodations

- 1. Extended Time
- 2. Reduced Assignments
- 3. Individual Google Classroom
- 4. Exemption from Group Work or Labs
- 5. Copy of Class Notes



Data to Discuss...

- 1. Current attendance record
- 2. Current grades (credit history)
- 3. Parent & Teacher feedback
- 4. Medical Needs Assessment
- 5. Current Schedule



Service Type

- Full Homebound All services provided by a homebound teacher.
- Intermittent Homebound Student attends school and homebound services are provided.

Homebound Instruction



Parent Acknowledgement

- An adult 18 years or older must be present
- Provide a quiet workspace for the session
- Remove household pets from the workspace
- Student should be ready for learning upon arrival
- > Student should have all necessary materials available
- Student cannot participate in extracurricular activities or working at a job

Prior to a Session...

- Parents sign an acknowledgement of service expectations
- > Preferred communication methods shared between teacher and parents
- Services days and times are confirmed
- Teacher reviews assignments or collects assignments from campus

During a session:

- Student will be required to complete work outside of direct homebound time
- Check in on current assignments and class requirements
- Help student to determine work that needs priority attention vs. work that student can complete independently
- Work on current assignments for core academic classes
- Work on additional classwork as time allows

Concluding a Session...

- Work completion log submitted to parent/student
- Weekly communication sent to teachers with updates
- Attendance is submitted at the end of the week to campus registrars
- Session times confirmed for the following week
