PTO INFORMATION





The deadline to make a 2024 tax credit donation to a school or student activity of your choice is April 15, 2025. Under the Arizona tax credit program, tax payers can direct a portion of their state income tax to a specific program such as sports or other extra-curricular activity, or to a school.
